This being a reserved matters application, and no hardcopy plans having been received, the application was noted but no resolution adopted.• DC/16/1278 - repositioning of store entrance and fascia sign; 5-9 Hyde Square, Upper Beeding. <p>P:0616:16 <i>Matters for information and future agendas</i></p>	<p>Cllr S Birnstingl noted a report he had read in the Horsham District Post: there is an increasing volume of planning applications which involve provision of shared sewage disposal plant rather than connection to the mains sewerage network. This method of waste disposal carries the risk that when the plant breaks down the raw sewage will make its way into natural watercourses, causing significant pollution. This will need to be borne in mind when considering any such application.</p>
