<b>S:0517:01</b> <i>Election of Chairman</i>	Cllr R Harber was nominated as Chairman, and having agreed in advance to accept office was elected unanimously. <i>Proposed by P Kentell; Seconded by A Chilver.</i>  In Cllr Harber's absence, Cllr S Birnstingl took the chair for this meeting.
<b>S:0517:02</b> <i>Election of Vice-Chairman</i>	Cllr C Warren was nominated as Vice-Chairman, to accept office, and was elected unanimously. <i>Proposed by P Kentell; Seconded by J Rowland.</i>
<b>S:0517:03</b> <i>Apologies</i>	Apologies were received from Cllrs K Bowlan (personal commitments), V Cook (illness), and R Harber (personal commitments).
<b>S:0517:04</b> <i>Questions from the public</i>	There were no questions from the public.
<b>S:0517:05</b> <i>Declarations of interest</i>	There were no declarations of personal or prejudicial interest by Councillors on any of the agenda items below.
<b>S:0517:06</b> <i>Minutes of previous meeting</i>	The minutes of the meeting dated 21 <sup>st</sup> March 2017 were approved by all present and signed by the Chairman.  <i>Proposed by A Chilver; Seconded by P Kentell.</i>
<b>S:0517:07</b> <i>Matters arising</i>	There were no matters arising from the minutes not covered elsewhere in the agenda.
<b>S:0517:08</b> <i>Cricket Club report</i>	Mr Robb reported orally as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The season is now underway, with Steyning playing on Saturdays. Two matches have so far been played.</li> <li>- It has proved very difficult to recruit new members to the club.</li> <li>- The club would like a key to the bollard at the entrance to the field</li> </ul> <p>The Clerk reminded Mr Robb that grass cuttings needed to be deposited in the allotments, not against neighbouring fences. The meeting suggested that club may wish to approach the school for a joint initiative for provision of facilities.</p>
